Frequently Asked Questions

- 1 How long will the sample collection take?**

 - Most blood and urine sample collection take just a few minutes. Specialized tests may take longer.
- 2 Can I eat after giving sample for the test?**

 - Yes! Once your sample is collected, you can eat and drink normally.
- 3 Will blood collection procedure hurt?**

 - You may feel a slight pinch during a blood collection, but it's usually quick and mild.
- 4 How soon will I get my results?**

 - Test results are ready within define time ,which can be differ according to test . Specialized tests may take longer.

Blood Tests

How to Prepare for Your Test:

1 Fasting Tests:

- If your doctor has asked you to fast, avoid eating or drinking anything except water for 8–12 hours before the test. Examples of fasting tests include blood sugar and lipid profile.

2 Non-Fasting Tests:

- You can eat and drink normally before these tests unless instructed otherwise by your doctor.

3 Urine Sample:

- Please collect your urine sample in the sterile container provided.
- For accurate results, it's best to collect a midstream sample (start urinating, pause, then collect).

4 Stool Sample:

- Collect a small portion of stool in the clean container provided.
- Make sure no urine or water gets mixed in with the stool sample.

5 Biopsy:

- If your doctor has recommended a biopsy, you'll receive specific instructions from your care team.

Important Points

- **Arrive On Time:** Please come at the scheduled time to avoid delays.
- **Bring Your Prescription:** Ensure you have the doctor's order or prescription for the tests.
- **Stay Hydrated:** Drink water unless you've been asked to fast.
- **Medications:** Inform our staff if you are taking any medications as some might affect your test results.
